

# Troop 376, Liberty, MO – Campout, February 15<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019

**Location and Information:**

We will camp at Snow Creek North of Platte City in Weston, MO. Bring cold weather gear and extra dry clothing. There are lockers in the ski lodge that use quarters; if you need a locker, please bring quarters. All Scouts should have extra spending money for snacks, drinks and/or Tubing and Lessons (\*See Notes).

**Registration and Cost:**

You **MUST** sign-up and/or pay for this campout by the meeting on **February 11<sup>th</sup> (no exceptions)**, or by contacting **Clint Cook (816-699-3884) or Mike Greenwald, camping376@gmail.com**. We would prefer that everyone who knows they will attend, to sign-up at the troop meeting on **Monday, February 4<sup>th</sup>** including payment. We need 15 paid skiers to receive the prices shown in the table. All Scouts and Leaders committing to go by the Monday night meeting, **February 11<sup>th</sup>** will be charged all appropriate fees even if they don't attend as this campout involves pre-costs to the troop for reservations and food. **Everyone will be required to use a helmet**, so the presumption is that one will be rented. If you have your own, you will need to advise the Camping Coordinator for credit.

**Notes:** If your scout has never skied, lessons are strongly encouraged. Tubing does require skiers to have a pair of winter boots to wear while tubing as the rental ski boots are not allowed. Snow board boots can be used as tubing boots. There is an option for 2 hours of Tubing for \$22, if your scout is interested in this please send cash with your scout to pay for this.

**Merit Badge:** If your scout is interested in the Snow Sports Merit Badge, they must have previous skiing experience.

**Departure:**

The Troop will meet at Liberty United Methodist Church on Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup> @ **6:00 PM** for check-in & departure. The Troop will return to Crowley Furniture parking lot around **7:00 PM (or possibly sooner)** on Saturday Evening, February 16<sup>th</sup> **If you plan to arrive late, leave early or leave during the campout, you MUST let the Camping Coordinators, Clint Cook or Mike Greenwald, or Scoutmaster, Mike Riley, know during sign-up or check-in.**

**Directions:** 1 Snow Creek Parkway, Weston, MO 64098

MO291 to I-435 to I-29 North to Exit 20, take a left from the exit ramp driving back over I-29. Turn right onto Hwy 273 to Weston. Stay on Hwy 273 to Hwy 45, turn right on Hwy 45 at the 4 way stop. Stay on Hwy 45 for approx. 8 miles. Snow Creek will be on your right about 1/4 mile past the Latan Power Plant.

Friday: Dinner on your own; Saturday: Breakfast and Lunch will be cooked by the Adult Leaders.
